Woodchurch Windmill Update

A start was made at the beginning of July on the long awaited refurbishment of the Windmill.

The sails and stocks have been removed so that the damaged sail can be replaced and the remainder inspected to assess their condition.

Scaffolding is erected to the top of the Windmill and the first task will be to remove the deteriorated parts of the fan tail structure.

A contractor has been appointed to undertake the timber repairs to cladding, window frames etc and then undertake a complete repaint. They will be starting this work at the beginning of August.

The repairs to the fantail structure and replacement of the sails will complete the works.

We appreciate the efforts of the premises team at Ashford Borough Council (the Windmill freeholders) for getting us to this long awaited milestone in the upkeep of our Windmill. Mel Bailey Chairman, Friends of Woodchurch Windmill.

Hub opening

As many of you have already discovered, the Hub is now open every weekday from 10 am till 4 pm. The Hub is here to help support the whole of the village community and to help promote local businesses and local tourism. The new community minibus "The Woodchurch Wagon" is being operated through the Hub and is being launched on the 4th August. If you can join us to share in this occasion then we look forward to seeing you. Over the next few months you will be seeing more village services become available through the Hub and we are always happy to receive new suggestions for other services that you think would be helpful for the village.

Just a reminder that we do stock a full range of local bus timetables, the Parish Magazine and the Wealden Advertiser. We can also help you with your photocopying, scanning and small run printing needs (currently only up to A4). We can laminate pages up to A3.

We have noticed recently that several village groups are using the Hub as a focal point to meet before starting a village activity. We are always happy to see you and would encourage more of you to do the same. With our new Hub sign in place we are easy to find – especially for visitors who are not familiar with the village.

The Hub will soon be stocking a selection of village souvenirs and post cards for sale and we have already increased our selection of Tourist Information leaflets. If you are in the village and create small local craft items which you would like us to display, please contact us for more information. Please be aware that, at least initially, our display space will be limited.

In order to keep the village Hub operating we are always in need of volunteers to help — especially during popular holiday periods. Some are needed to support inside the Hub itself and others to help with other projects around the Hub. If you can spare 3 hours a week, a few hours a fortnight, or even only a few hours a month, please contact us to discuss further.

Village Website, Business Directory, Accommodation and Sponsorship

As the current Information Centre and Parish Council Web sites are combined into the new Hub Web site we are adding some additional services and updated existing ones. We have already updated the local clubs and societies Directory and are about to start on the Directory for local businesses in Woodchurch and surrounding villages.
